2015 LOW INCOME MULTIFAMILY (4 UNITS OR MORE) TOILET & CLOTHES WASHER PROGRAM

1. Confirm the building has 4 units or more, is located within Seattle Public Utilities' direct service area and tenants meet the Income Eligibility. Perform audit to determine accurate number of **pre-2004 toilets to be replaced and confirm building has not previously received toilets through this program.**
2. Top-loading clothes washers in common areas are eligible to be replaced with efficient front-loading models.

5. Wait until you receive an authorization letter before proceeding. Select qualifying toilets (and clothes washers if applicable). Contact supplier to make delivery and scheduling arrangements, and select your plumber.
6. Install new toilets. **You must replace all (pre-2004) toilets in the building with Premium 1.06 gpf (or less) toilets. (See list at www.savingwater.org/rebates).**
7. Complete your project and submit Completion Form and receipts for toilets and installation (with breakdown of price of toilets, accessories and labor) to the address above.
