

EMERGENCY WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Construction update for September 5 – 11

Emergency work continues on Western Avenue to replace a water main at risk of failure. From September 5 – 11, you can expect the following impacts in the project area:

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Work will continue on Western Avenue between Yesler Way and Marion Street during the day Tuesday through Saturday.
- Sawcutting, excavating and installing pipe between Yesler Way and Marion Street with increased noise and dust.
- Some night work is expected next week, with the noisiest work completed by 10 p.m. each night.
- No work will occur on Sunday, September 6 and Monday, September 7.

TRAFFIC


- Western Avenue between Marion Street and Yesler Way will be closed to vehicle traffic from 6 a.m. – 3 p.m. One southbound lane will be open from 3 p.m. – 6 a.m.
- Some intermittent southbound lane closures are expected between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. next week to accommodate night work.
- Large vehicles travelling southbound on Western Avenue should detour at Marion Street or Madison Street.
- Vehicles can access the ferry terminal via Madison Street.

PARKING

- No on-street parking between Yesler Way and Marion Street.

PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS

- Pedestrian access will be maintained between Yesler Way and Spring Street. Sidewalks may be closed at times to safely accommodate work next to the walkway, especially between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. for night work.
- Steel plates may be present on the roadway. Bicyclists should use extreme caution.
