


EMERGENCY WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Construction update for October 10 to 16

Emergency work continues on Western Avenue to replace a water main at risk of failure. From October 10 to 16, you can expect the following impacts in the project area:

WEEKEND INTERSECTION CLOSURE

- Marion Street will be closed to through traffic between Post and Western avenues from 6 a.m. Saturday, October 10 to 5 a.m. Monday, October 12 to perform work in the intersection of Western Avenue. Local access will be provided.
- Detours will be available eastbound at Spring Street and westbound at Yesler Way. One southbound lane of traffic will remain open on Western Avenue between Spring Street and Yesler Way. Traffic may be stopped or detoured intermittently to accommodate work.
- Work will occur 24 hours per day over the weekend, with the noisiest work ending by 10 p.m. each night.
- Some low lighting may be used in the work zone at night.

WEEKDAY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Work will continue on Western Avenue between Yesler Way and Marion Street during the day Monday, October 12 through Friday, October 16.
- Western Avenue between Marion Street and Yesler Way will be closed to vehicle traffic from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m. One southbound lane will be open from 3 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Work will include sawcutting, excavating and installing new pipe between Columbia and Marion streets with increased noise and dust. Restoration work will occur between Yesler Way and Columbia Street.
- Some night work is expected next week, with the noisiest work completed by 10 p.m. each night.

ACCESS AND PARKING

- Large vehicles travelling southbound on Western Avenue should detour at Marion or Madison streets.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained between Yesler Way and Spring Street.
- No on-street parking between Yesler Way and Marion Street.
- Steel plates may be present in the roadway. Bicyclists should use extreme caution.
