

EMERGENCY WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Construction update for October 31 to November 6



Emergency work continues on Western Avenue to replace a water main at risk of failure. From October 31 to November 6, you can expect the following impacts in the project area:

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Work will occur from Yesler Way to Madison Street on Monday through Saturday during daytime hours.
- Mobilization of equipment, sawcutting and excavation between Marion and Madison streets with increased noise and dust.
- Backfilling and surface restoration work between Columbia and Marion streets.
- Continued surface restoration work between Yesler Way and Columbia Street.
- A weekend closure of the intersection at Western Avenue and Madison Street is expected in the coming weeks. More detailed information will be provided prior to the closure.

ACCESS AND PARKING

- Western Avenue between Yesler Way and Madison Street will be closed to vehicle traffic from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- One southbound lane will be open on Western Avenue from 3 p.m. to 6 a.m. with some intermittent closures to accommodate work.
- Large vehicles should detour to avoid Western Avenue between Madison Street and Yesler Way.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained between Yesler Way and Spring Street. Some intermittent sidewalk closures may be needed to accommodate work.
- No on-street parking between Madison Street and Yesler Way.
