


EMERGENCY WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Construction update for November 7 to 13

Emergency work continues on Western Avenue to replace a water main at risk of failure. From November 7 to 13, you can expect the following impacts in the project area:

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Work will occur from Columbia to Madison streets on Monday through Saturday during daytime hours. Work will occur on Veterans' Day, November 11.
- Some night work is expected next week, with the noisiest work completed by 10 p.m. each night.
- Mobilization of equipment, sawcutting and excavation between Marion and Madison streets with increased noise and dust.
- Backfilling and surface restoration work between Columbia and Marion streets.
- A weekend closure of the intersection at Western Avenue and Madison Street will occur 6 a.m. Saturday, November 14 to 12 p.m. Sunday, November 15.



ACCESS AND PARKING

- Western Avenue between Columbia and Madison streets will be closed to vehicle traffic from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- One southbound lane will be open on Western Avenue from 3 p.m. to 6 a.m. with some intermittent closures to accommodate work.
- Large vehicles should detour to avoid Western Avenue between Madison Street and Yesler Way.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained between Yesler Way and Spring Street. Some intermittent sidewalk closures may be needed to accommodate work.
- No on-street parking between Madison and Columbia streets.
