

EMERGENCY WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Construction update for the week of August 17, 2015


Emergency work continues on Western Avenue to replace a water main at risk of failure. Next week, you can expect the following impacts in the project area:

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Work will continue on Western Avenue between Yesler Way and Marion Street. Work hours are Monday through Saturday both day and night.
- Continued sawcutting and pavement breaking between Yesler Way and Marion Street with increased noise and dust.
- Some tree branches will be trimmed on the east side of Western Avenue between Yesler Way and Spring Street to allow construction vehicles and equipment to pass and avoid damage to trees.

TRAFFIC

- Intermittent impacts to traffic between Marion and Spring streets to accommodate tree trimming. Follow detour signs and flaggers' instructions.
- Western Avenue between Marion Street and Yesler Way will be closed to vehicle traffic from 6 AM – 3 PM. One southbound lane will be open from 3PM – 6AM.



PARKING

- No on-street parking between Yesler Way and Marion Street.
- Intermittent impacts to parking between Marion and Spring streets to accommodate tree branch trimming.

PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS

- Pedestrian access will be maintained between Yesler Way and Spring Street. Sidewalks may be briefly closed to safely accommodate work next to the walkway.
- Steel plates may be present on the roadway. Bicyclists should use extreme caution.
