Notice of Rulemaking

Under the authority of the Seattle Municipal Code 3.32.020 (adoption of rules) and SMC 22.802.030 (permissible discharges), the Director of Seattle Public Utilities is proposing rule DWW-370.1, “Conditional Discharge of Contaminated Industrial Stormwater to the Sanitary Sewer” and requests public review and comment.

A summary of the rule follows:

- Discharge of contaminated industrial stormwater to the sanitary sewer system requires approval by SPU per Seattle Municipal Code and King County Industrial Waste (KCIW) per King County Code.
- SPU Discharge Approval is required to discharge Contaminated Industrial Stormwater (CISW).
- Applicants who receive SPU Discharge Approval must agree to all terms and conditions by signing the Discharge Approval, including the allowable discharge rate and compliance reporting requirements.
- Applicants who are denied SPU Discharge Approval may request Director’s review in accordance with the procedures and requirements of SMC 21.16.358 D.
