Rebuilding for the Future of Solid Waste

North Transfer Station is closed for rebuild

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) is replacing the North Transfer Station with a more modern and efficient facility that will meet the growing future needs of the city. The old facility will be torn down and a new facility will be constructed in its place. The new North Transfer Station is expected to open in 2016.

What to expect during construction

- Work hours
 - Monday through Friday, 7:00am to 5:00pm
 - Saturday (if necessary) 9:00am to 6:00pm.
- Construction trailers will be located on the southeast corner of the site at N 34th Street and Woodlawn Ave N.
- Construction traffic will enter the site on N 34th Street and exit on N 35th Street (existing entrance and exit locations).
- Carr Place parking lot will remain undisturbed through 2014 and will be used for construction worker parking.
- Carr Place N between N 34th Street and N 35th Street will be permanently closed after the start of construction.
- The contractor will comply with noise limitations established by local ordinances and project permits.
- The contractor will follow best management practices for controlling dust and dirt in the area and will make sure construction dirt is not left on the streets.
- Construction workers will be required to park onsite or at the Carr Place parking lot. On-street parking by construction workers in the residential neighborhood will be discouraged.

Directions to South Transfer Station

1. Take WA-99 S/Aurora Ave N; drive south over the First Avenue South Bridge.
2. Take the first exit (South Park/WA-99) after the bridge.
3. Stay right and follow the street as it curves under the bridge.
4. Continue to stay right and go straight through intersection at S. Holden Street.
5. Take the next right exit (South Park/South Kenyon Street); follow Transfer Station signs.
6. Enter through second gate on right.
