

EMERGENCY WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Construction update for the week of August 24, 2015


Emergency work continues on Western Avenue to replace a water main at risk of failure. For the week of August 24, you can expect the following impacts in the project area:

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Work will continue on Western Avenue between Yesler Way and Marion Street Monday through Saturday both day and night.
- Sawcutting, pavement breaking, and excavating to occur between Yesler Way and Marion Street with increased noise and dust.
- Night work will begin in the coming weeks, with the noisiest work completed by 10 p.m. each night.

TRAFFIC

- Western Avenue between Marion Street and Yesler Way will be closed to vehicle traffic from 6 a.m. – 3 p.m. One southbound lane will be open from 3 p.m. – 6 a.m.
- Large vehicles travelling southbound on Western Avenue should detour at Marion Street or Madison Street.
- Vehicles can access the ferry terminal via Madison Street.



PARKING

- No on-street parking on Western Avenue between Yesler Way and Marion Street.

PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS

- Pedestrian access will be maintained between Yesler Way and Spring Street. Sidewalks may be briefly closed to safely accommodate work next to the walkway.
- Steel plates may be present on the roadway. Bicyclists should use extreme caution.
