NOTICE OF PROPOSED TEXT AMENDMENT AND CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING

The Department of Planning and Development (DPD) is proposing amendments to Seattle's Grading and Drainage Control Code (Seattle Municipal Code, Title 22 Subtitle VIII), Land Use Code (Seattle Municipal Code, Title 23) and Environmentally Critical Areas Code (Seattle Municipal Code, Title 25) to designate and regulate Peat Settlement-prone Geologic Hazard Areas.

PUBLIC HEARING

The City Council's Environment, Emergency Management & Utilities Committee will hold a public hearing to take comments on the proposal on May 14, 2008 at 5:30 p.m. The hearing will be held in Council Chambers, 2nd floor, Seattle City Hall, 600 Fourth Avenue. The entrances to City Hall are located on the west side of Fifth Avenue and the east side of Fourth Avenue, between James and Cherry Streets. For those who wish to testify, a sign-up sheet will be available outside the Council Chamber one-half hour before the public hearing.
