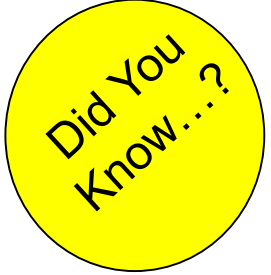

The first traffic signal in Seattle was installed in 1924

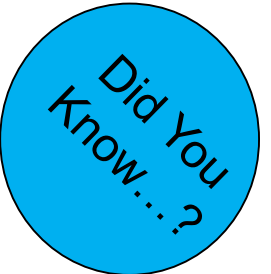
