Background and context

Seattle Municipal Code – Marijuana Businesses (SMC 6.500)

SMC 6.500.110 – State regulatory provisions; Director to adopt rules

The Director shall adopt rules that incorporate applicable provisions of the Washington Administrative Code relating to the regulation of marijuana businesses by the Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board, and shall periodically review and update such rules as changes are made to such provisions of the Washington Administrative Code.

Background and context

- ❖ 2017 16 WAC rules adopted as FAS Director's Rules
- Rules chosen to promote consumer protection and public health.
- Rules chosen based on authority and capacity to regulate.
- ❖ 2021 Nine rules require amending to align with WAC.
- ❖ 2021 Seven rules remain unchanged.
- ❖ 2021 Seven additional rules are considered for adoption.
