Dear Seattle Ethics and Elections Commission,

It has come to my attention that the Jon Grant for City Council campaign and related independent expenditure campaigns have gone over the campaign spending limit, as defined in SMC 2.04.630(f). Please see the attached breakdown, courtesy of Wayne Barnett.

Spending Limit prior to Primary Release: \$146,189 Voucher Disbursements since 8/4: \$147,150 Monetary Contributions since 8/4: \$4,461 IE Spending: \$1,627 Unredeemed Vouchers: \$2,200

Total: \$301,627

Given that the Grant campaign is currently petitioning for release from the spending limits, I believe the current overage plus his further fundraising after release is materially over the \$300,000 limit imposed by I-122. My understanding is that this material difference now qualifies People for Teresa for consideration to be released from the spending limits as well.

Given that the Grant campaign is currently over the spending limits imposed by I-122 and his current petition for release will allow him to immediately raise well past that amount, my understanding is I am now eligible to be considered for the same release. I respectfully request to be released from the spending limits. Thank you for your consideration.
