Introductions may be submitted to the Seattle Ethics and Elections Commission from January XX, 2019 – May 31, 2019. Candidate introductions will be translated into 14 languages and made available on the Democracy Voucher website.

Introductions are subject to rules SMC XX.

- Proofread for errors. (Staff will not proofread statements.)
