Introductions

The May 2022 meeting minutes were reviewed and approved with no edits.

Update on Work Progress, Reports and Safety

Work Progress

They are in the midst of concrete work. There was a 1,700 yard pour last Saturday, and an 1,800 yard pour is planned this coming Saturday. Concrete will be the main focus in the coming months, with carpenters, laborers, operators and ironworkers. The pours will allow them to start going vertical. They're working on building the tank, which will likely last through September. There's also a temporary structure over the roadway, which is an added scope with existing subs.

Other than concrete, there will be some electrical work in the next few months. There will also be a small amount of structural steel in August and more in November. Electrical and plumbing work will ramp back up in December.

Turner has ramped up with self-performed work, with about 35-40 workers on site. They're looking to hire Priority Hire workers where available.

The project is 29% complete.

Safety

There were two minor safety incidents with ankle injuries; neither were recordable. Both workers were on light duty but returned to full duty a few weeks ago. There were COVID-19 updates.

There have been a few break-ins over the last several months, with people stealing electrical cords. Otherwise, there have been no issues.
