Infertility previously had to be proven before treatment was medically approved, which created barriers for some queer families and people who would like to become pregnant.

Now:

All individuals have similar access to infertility treatments and services



Doubled Maximum Lifetime Benefit

In 2021, the lifetime benefit maximum for fertility care was \$10,000, which only provided baseline coverage for many.

Now:

\$20,000 lifetime fertility benefit maximum



More Treatments and Services Covered

Previously, Artificial Insemination and Ovulation Induction were covered, but many other fertility treatments were not included, which made the benefit less valuable to employees.

Now:

5 additional benefits are now covered under the lifetime benefit:

- Advanced Reproductive Technology (ART)
- Pre-Implantation Genetic Testing
- 2 Eggs, Embryo and Sperm retrievals and
 12 months Storage & Thawing
- Cryopreservation
- Reimbursement of donor sperm
