On behalf of the City of Seattle, Department of Neighborhoods, Seattle Fire Department, and the Office of Policy Management, I would like to follow-up on a request that was submitted on March 28, 2008 via the "Report on Mandatory Compliance Efforts in the Seattle Alcohol Impact Areas."

As the Chief of the Police for the Seattle Police Department and in accordance with the WAC 314-12-215 Alcohol Impact Areas-Definition-Guidelines (4)(a), I support and request the addition of the following products to the banned products list for Seattle's existing alcohol impact areas:

- Joose
- Sparks
- Tilt
- Icehouse
- Camo Black Ice
- Maximum Ice
- Evil Eye
- Johnny Bootlegger

The list of products have been identified by Seattle businesses and community groups as problematic, as they have accounted for nearly 32 percent of alcohol containers in litter pickups.
