Topic

- Standards and Duties (Ferrier Warning)

Summary of Management Action:

- Allegations that employees failed to provide Ferrier warning before entering and searching a residence. OPA attributed this to lack of search and seizure training employees have typically received.

OPA Recommendation:

- The Training Unit should create a search and seizure training module and provide it to all officers assigned to the Patrol Operations Bureau, at a minimum.

Action Taken:

- The Education and Training Section has completed an updated Search and Seizure training which includes Ferrier Warnings. This is a mandatory class that all officers must complete as part of their training requirements for 2019.

Final Disposition:

- Recommendation Fully Implemented
