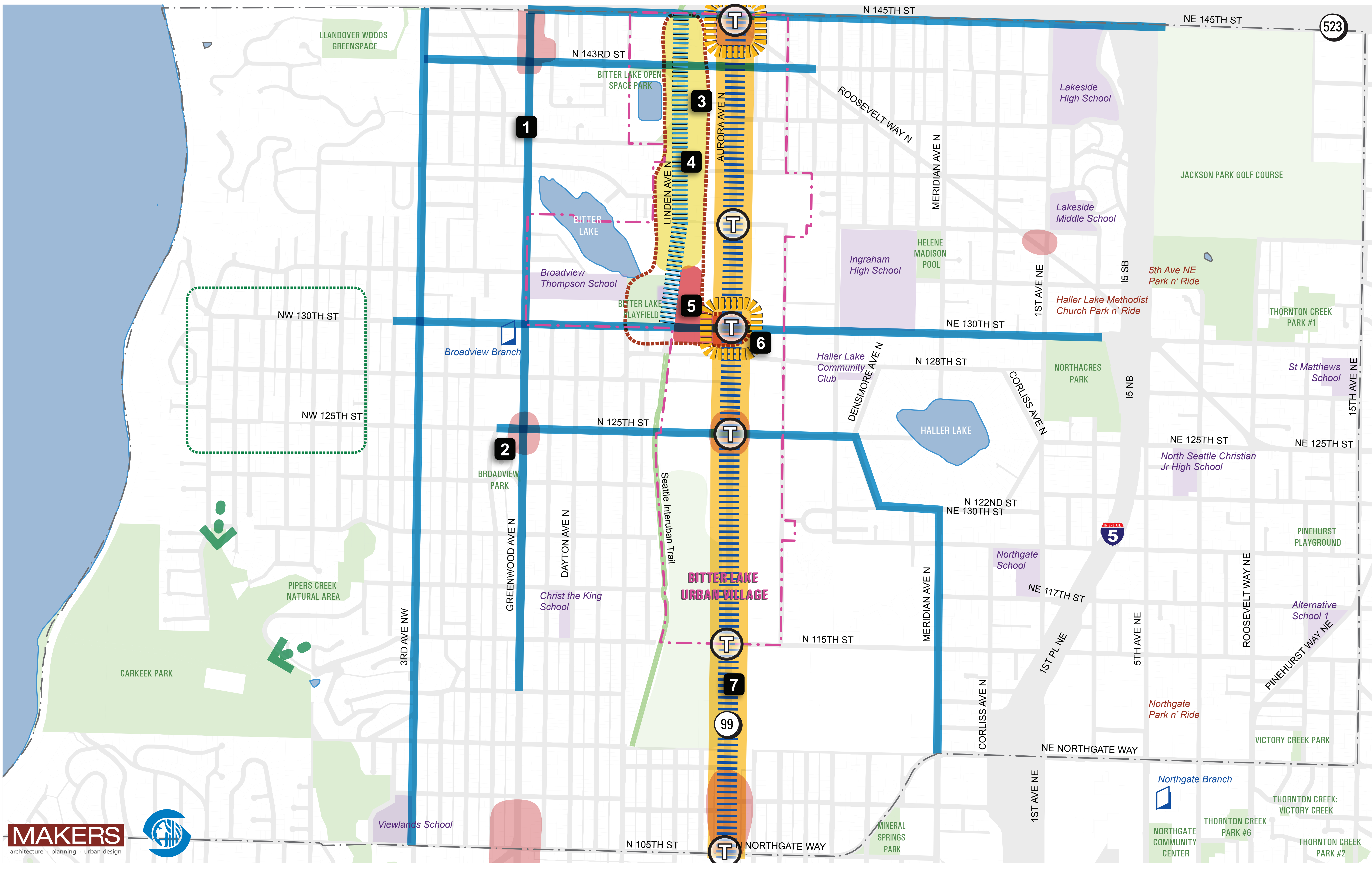


Overall Urban Design

The major ideas we heard from you

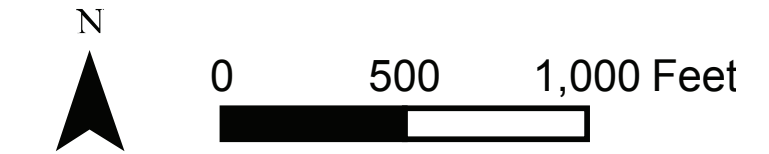


- 1** Improve walkability on arterials to create a network of “complete streets.”
- 2** Enhance retail “hamlets” along Greenwood Ave, with sidewalk improvements and appropriate building regulations.
- 3** Create a “Town Center” around an improved Linden Ave N, with a dense, vibrant mix of residences and businesses, and park resources.
- 4** Designate a high-quality, dense, multifamily neighborhood, building on existing (and recent) housing development.
- 5** Create a highly walkable neighborhood shopping district with a mix of street-level stores and housing above, a network of walkways, and gathering areas.
- 6** Create gateway feature, improve streetscape, and orient commercial activity to Rapid Ride station area to mark entry into Linden
- 7** Undertake a comprehensive corridor plan for Aurora Ave N addressing the design of the streetscape (road, sidewalk, trees, landscaping, parking, lighting, etc.), transit, and surrounding development.
