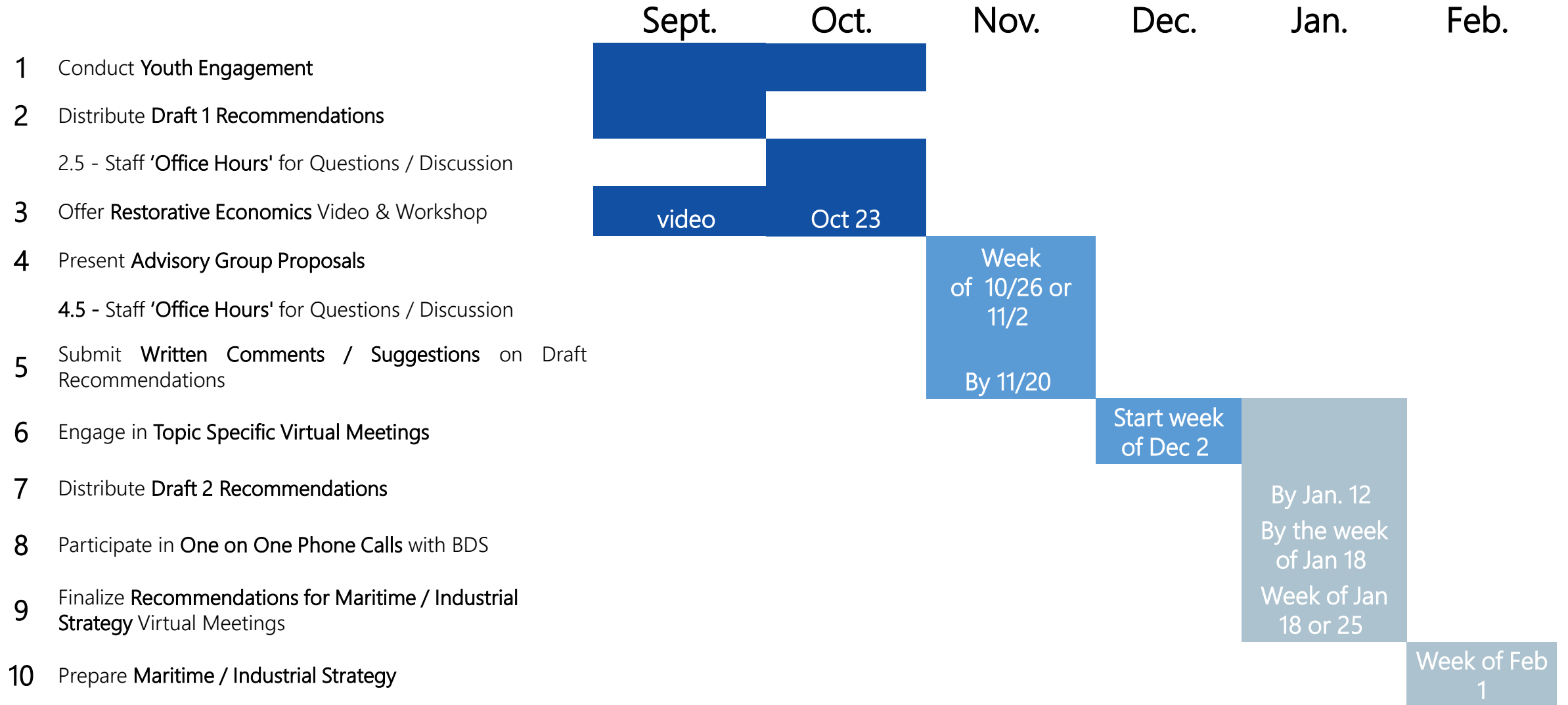


## Final Stakeholder Recommendations Meeting Late January
