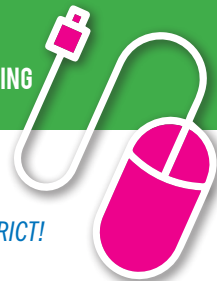

# PORTAGE BAY PARK

Seattle Parks and Recreation invites the community to an online open house about the preferred design of a new waterfront park on Portage Bay.

The goal for the project is to design a park that provides shoreline/water-related experiences for all ages and abilities. The park will provide small gathering areas, picnic spots and informal recreational opportunities. It will include hand carried boat access, natural shoreline habitat, and interpretative and educational elements. The project also includes cleanup of site contamination, building demolition, and potential partial re-use of building elements.
