SUBJECT: Bias Crimes and Bias Incidents Synopsis - (2nd Half 2017 dates 07/01/17-12/31/17)

Overview

During the second half of 2017, a total of **240** criminal and non-criminal bias based incidents were reported to the Seattle Police Department. This compares to **128** bias based incidents reported in the second half of 2016. This reflects an 88% increase of bias based incidents, city-wide.

Malicious harassment cases increased by 33%, the category of crimes with bias elements rose 111%, and non-criminal bias incidents rose 112%, respectively from the same period of time in 2016.

Reported **anti-LGBTQ** malicious harassment cases numbered 25 during the first half of 2017, and decreased to 20 during the second half of 2017.

Reported **anti-Black** malicious harassment cases numbered 10 during the second half of 2016, and increased to 15 during the second half of 2017. Reported anti-Black crimes with bias elements increased from 17 reported incidents during the second half of 2016 to 25 during the second half of 2017.

The majority of reported incidents occurred during **second watch hours** (116), followed by **third watch at 63** and **first watch at 62**.

West Precinct had the most incidents, accounting for 30% of the total number city wide, followed by North Precinct at 28% and East Precinct at 22%. South Precinct reported 10% of the incidents, followed by Southwest Precinct at 10%. 2% of cases occurred at an unknown Seattle location, or outside of the city.

Incidents

- ✓ 52 were determined to be Malicious Harassment
- \checkmark 99 of the incidents were determined to be crimes with bias elements
- \checkmark 89 of the incidents were determined to be non-criminal bias incidents

Arrests

- ✓ 19 total cases resulted in an arrest in 52 Malicious Harassment crimes:
 - o 14 were arrested and/or charged with a felony crime
 - o 6 were arrested and/or charged with a misdemeanor offense
 - o 0 cases were cleared exceptional- the victim did not want to press charges
 - 29 cases were inactivated or administratively cleared due to solvability or other factors
 - 3 cases remain open and under investigation

21 total cases resulted in an arrest out of 99 crimes with bias elements

- 4 were arrested and/or charged with a felony crime
- \circ 21 were arrested and/or charged with a misdemeanor offense
- 72 cases were inactivated or administratively cleared due to solvability or other factors
- 2 cases remain open. 1 case remains open with a known suspect in warrant status, and the other has a good lead.

Bias Categories

The bias-based events targeted eighteen total groups with the two most frequent groups, anti-black and anti-gay/lesbian accounting for 50% of the total bias based incidents.

- The category of Anti-Black represents 29% of the total reported incidents.
- The aggregated categories of Anti-Gay and Lesbian, Transgender, and Gender Non-Conforming represent 26% percent of the incidents.
- 26% of the criminal and non-criminal bias incidents occurred during 1st watch hours (0300-1159)
- 48% of the criminal and non-criminal bias incidents occurred during 2nd watch hours (1200-1959)
- 26% of the criminal and non-criminal bias incidents occurred during 3rd watch hours (2000-0259)

• David Sector represents **24%** of the total crimes and **23%** of the non-criminal bias incidents in the West Precinct.

• King Sector represents **39%** of the total crimes and **45%** of the non-criminal bias incidents in the West Precinct.

• Mary Sector represents 24% of the total crimes and 23% of the non-criminal bias incidents in the West Precinct.

• Queen Sector represents **12%** of the total crimes and **9%** of the non-criminal bias incidents in the West Precinct.
