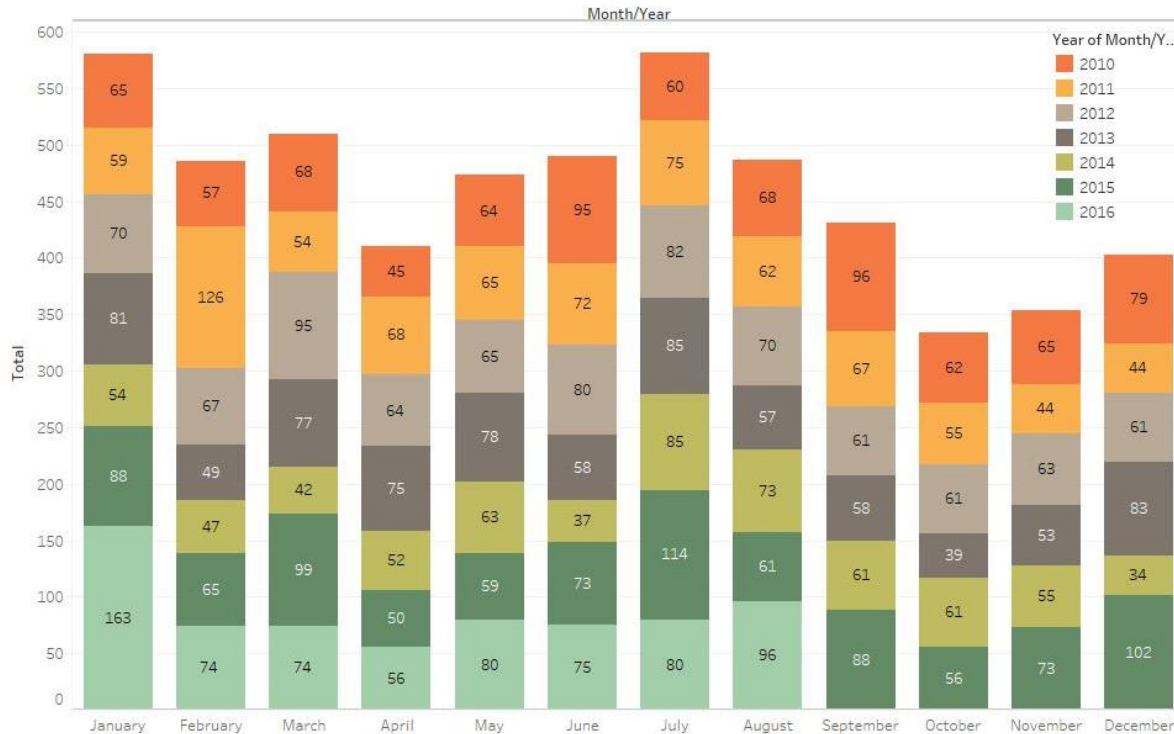

Yearly Guns Taken into Custody

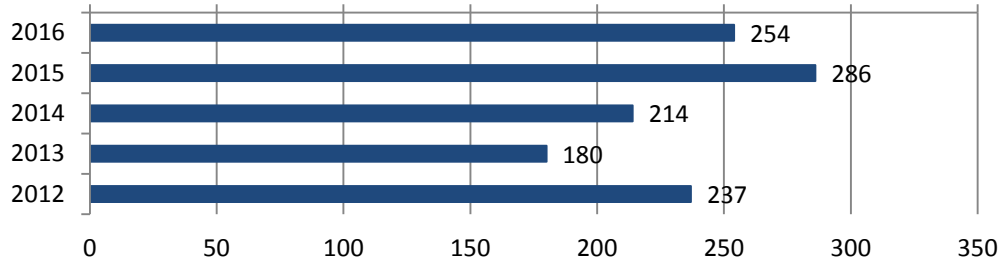

Guns Taken into Custody (by Mo.)

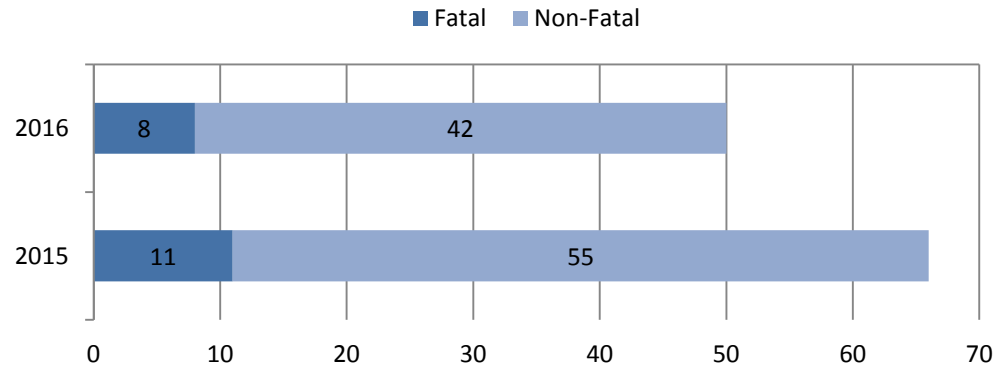


# SHOTS FIRED REPORT
