4. Relentless Follow-Up and Assessment





WEST PRECINCT MCPP: INTERNATIONAL DISTRICT

Identified Issues:

- Narcotics Public sales and use
- 2. Street Disorder Civility issues
- Homeless Camps/Camping

Strategies:

- Install Boxes for anonymous reporting
- Utilize SPD Patrol resources with Hot Spot Areas to increase police presence
- Continue to clean up homeless camps with SDOT and WADOT crews
- Repost camp areas at the same time as clean up to facilitate a quicker response

Outreach:

- Educating Businesses/Residents on MCPP
- Focus Groups
- Block Watch
- Constantly Communicating with Community face to face, emails and phone conversations

- Administered Community Surveys of Crime


