



FIREARMS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY


Firearms Taken into Custody by Year January 1 to September 30 (2010-2015)

Firearms are obtained through civilian turn-ins, surrenders, found property, and criminal investigations.




SHOTS FIRED

Shots Fired January 1 to October 12 (2012-2015)




Shootings by Injury Type January 1 to October 12 (2014 and 2015)
