Subject:	Environmental Justice Matrix for the 2022 Safe Routes to School (FHWA) Project

This memo provides responses to the questions identified in Appendix M of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Categorical Exclusions (CE) Guidebook.

**Question 1:** Are any protected populations present within the proposed limits of the project's impacts?

**Response 1:** A 0.5-mile buffer was established around each segment of the project area using the EJ Screen tool. Additionally, the nearest elementary school to each project segment was identified and queried on the Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction's Washington State Report Card online tool. Results were as follows:

Greenwood segment: The 2010 Census Summary Report indicates 26% of the population within this buffer were People of Color. The ACS Summary Report for 2015-2019 estimated 24% of the population within this buffer were People of Color. 16% of the population age 5+ years indicated a language other than English is spoken at home. The Broadview-Thomas K-8 School total student enrollment summary for 2021-2022 indicates 71.5% of the 562 students identified as one non-white race, or two or more races. 23.7% of all students were categorized as English language learners.

1<sup>st</sup> Ave NW – North Neighborhood Greenway segment: The 2010 Census Summary Report indicates 29% of the population within this buffer were People of Color. The ACS Summary Report for 2015-2019 estimated 30% of the population within this buffer were People of Color. 18% of the population age 5+ years indicated a language other than English is spoken at home. The nearest elementary school to this segment is also the Broadview-Thomas K-8 School, described in the previous section.

1<sup>st</sup> Ave NW – South Neighborhood Greenway segment: The 2010 Census Summary Report indicates 25% of the population within this buffer were People of Color. The ACS Summary Report for 2015-2019 estimated 22% of the population within this buffer were People of Color. 14% of the population age 5+ years indicated a language other than English is spoken at home. The Viewlands Elementary School total student enrollment summary for 2021-2022 indicates 51.6% of the 285 students identified as one non-white race, or two or more races. 20.4% of all students were categorized as English language learners. NE 135<sup>th</sup> St segment: The 2010 Census Summary Report indicates 43% of the population within this buffer were People of Color. The ACS Summary Report for 2015-2019 estimated 45% of the population within this buffer were People of Color. 34% of the population age 5+ years indicated a language other than English is spoken at home. The Cedar Park Elementary School total student enrollment summary for 2021-2022 indicates 46.9% of the 224 students identified as one non-white race, or two or more races. 8.5% of all students were categorized as English language learners.

**Question 2:** Does the project require permanent right-of-way acquisition? **Response 2:** No. The project will include temporary work outside the right-of-way via Temporary Construction Easements (TCEs), but no permanent property will be acquired.

These findings are documented on the CE form, including demographic data. The Summary Reports referenced in Response 1 are attached to this document. The segment name is included in the upper left corner of each report's first page.

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


