EMERGENCY CONSTRUCTION WORK

August 12, 2022

DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) will perform emergency construction work on a water main in your neighborhood. Crews will install a new pipe, tap, and intertie connection.

This work is associated with the 430 Pipeline Improvement project. The large 430 pipeline was built in the early 1900s and runs four miles from Volunteer Park to Maple Leaf Reservoir in Seattle. It is a part of the region's drinking water system and work is underway to repair portions of the pipe.

LOCATION:

The 430 Pipeline Improvement project is a multisite project. Construction at this site takes place on **NE 55th Street between 17th Ave NE and NE 18th Ave** and will occur in the street and portions of the sidewalk.

SCHEDULE:

Work will occur on **Tuesday, August 16, or Wednesday, August 17, from 7 am to 5 pm**. Noisy work will begin after 8 am. Upon completion of the work that day, metal plates will be placed over the sidewalk and street. Crews are scheduled to return the **week on August 22** to complete the work.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- Pavement excavation, construction noise, dust, dirt, and vibrations
- Temporary closure of the north sidewalk while crews are working
- Parking restrictions near the work area
- Slowed vehicle traffic, heavy equipment, and construction vehicles near the work area
- Some water flowing along the curb
