2015 – 2016 school year

- Started in Feb. 2016
- 2,500 ORCA cards available
- 300 ORCA cards distributed
- Middle and high school students that live between
 1 2 miles from school
- Must be eligible for Free and Reduced Lunch

2016 – 2017 school year


- 3,000 ORCA cards available
- 1,500 ORCA cards distributed
- High school students that live less than 2 miles
- 200% of the federal poverty guidelines, consistent with ORCA LIFT
