




Seattle Children's Hospital
Tree Preservation and
Protection

The City's tree protection ordinance, SMC 25.11, applies to development authorized by this MIMP. In addition, to the extent feasible, any trees that exceed 6 caliper inches in width measured three feet above the ground and that are located within the Laurelon expansion area shall be used on Children's campus.
