1. Property Name: PMA# 1260; Eastgate Reservoir (AKA Eastside Reservoir)

- 2. **Property Location**: Between 146th and 148th Avenues SE at approximately SE 44th St in Bellevue, Washington. Northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 15, Township 24 N, Range 5 E.
- 3. Legal Description: That portion of Section 15, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of the southeast 1/4 of said Section 15; thence westerly along the north line of said southeast 1/4, North 89° 20' 48" West, a distance of 883.80 feet; thence South 32° 11' 25" East, a distance of 219.01 feet to a point of curve from which the radial center bears South 57° 48' 35" West, a distance of 528.00 feet; thence southeasterly along said curve to the right, an arc distance of 218.67 feet to a point on the curve from which the radial center bears South 81° 32' 18" West, a distance of 528.00 feet; thence South 69° 43' 12" East, a distance of 741.720 feet to the east line of said southeast 1/4; thence North 00° 22' 04" West along said east line, a distance of 635.95 feet to the point of beginning; Situate in the County of King, State of Washington.

- 8. **Current easements, covenants and restrictions:** Easement granted by City of Seattle to Eastgate Sewer District in 1976 for a sanitary sewer along a portion of the southerly boundary.
- 9. **Current King County assessed value**: Total for both parcels = \$10,303,100.00


