Crossing Guard Subcommittee Update

Ashley Rhead distributed the crossing guard prioritization matrix. The subcommittee has developed this to do a systematic review of crossing guard locations throughout the city, making it data-based. She explained that the subcommittee added some new locations which were not previously staffed but have safety issues that rank them high in the matrix. There are also some previously-staffed locations that do not rank high and will lose their guards. The subcommittee is working next on communications to schools about crossing guard services. Subcommittee to meet again this afternoon.

Request for Committee Letter for 32nd Ave W and W Raye St.

Pat Kraft returned to discuss this intersection. The group discussed the issues, the history of study at the location, and the assessed problems that have not been addressed. After the discussion, the group respectfully decided not to send a letter in support of a 4-way stop. Members made suggestions about enforcement (hedge maintenance), possible Neighborhood Street Fund project, and the need to be sure that the school buses use the area properly.

- **ACTION**: Richard Staudt to speak with SPS Transportation (Kyle Brown) again about ensuring that buses wait no closer than 20 feet to the crosswalk. Note: a "bus load" sign may need to be moved or added. Also, 2 buses that use the area across the street (on the SE corner) need to use space properly.
- **ACTION**: This committee will reply to Pat Kraft when that work has been completed. (Richard or Jen?)
