



## Stairway replacement at S Hanford St between Cheasty Blvd S and Morse Ave S

### PROJECT UPDATE

To improve pedestrian safety and accessibility, Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) crews are replacing the stairway at S Hanford St between Cheasty Blvd S and Morse Ave S.

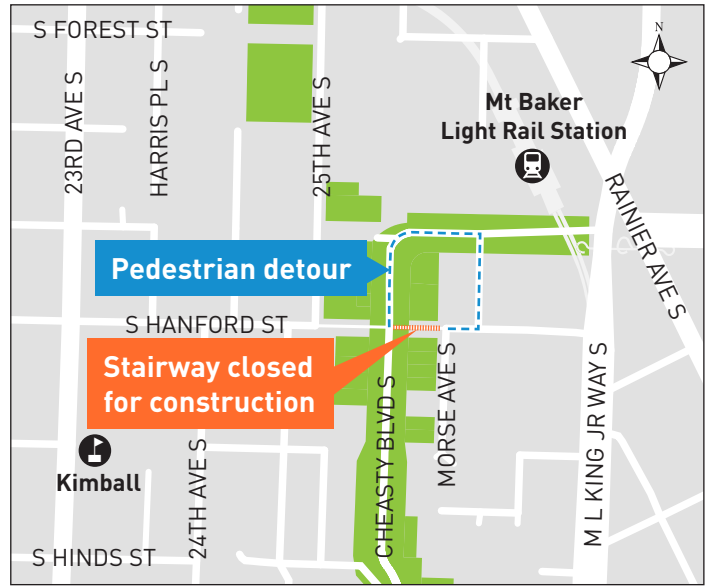
### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Improvements include:

- Replacing the existing stairs with a new stairway made of reinforced concrete, with multiple landings and even heights for each step
- Adding landscaping on both sides of the new stairway

### CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled for early April through late-May, depending on weather. The stairway will be closed during most of the work. See map for pedestrian detour route.



### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Typical work hours between 7 AM and 3:30 PM on weekdays
- Some noisy work activity including digging and backup alarms required for safety
- Intermittent lane restrictions at top and bottom of stairway during work
- Pedestrian detours around the work zone
