# 25TH AVENUE NE PAVING PROJECT

WINTER 2018

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This summer, we're planning to repave about 4 miles of 25th Ave NE between Montlake Blvd and NE 65th St (see map on reverse). Repaving will make the street more comfortable to drive on and extend its useful life.

### PROJECT ELEMENTS

This maintenance project will:

- Repave and restripe 25th Ave NE between Montlake Blvd NE and NE 65th St; restriping will maintain current street operations
- Install and upgrade curb ramps in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Replace traffic sensors that control signals
- Make bus stop improvements, including a new shelter near NE Blakely St

### BENEFITS

We know how important it is to maintain our streets, and our Paving Program helps take care of the basics by rehabilitating arterial streets each year. Arterial streets are primary routes for moving people and goods through the city. They connect business districts to one another and the regional transportation network.

Keeping our transportation system in a state of good repair helps lower the cost of future maintenance and extends the useful life of our roads.

### SCHEDULE

- Early 2018 – Finalize project design
- Spring 2018 – Pre-construction coordination with the community and businesses
- Summer 2018 – Begin construction
- Late 2018 – Complete construction
