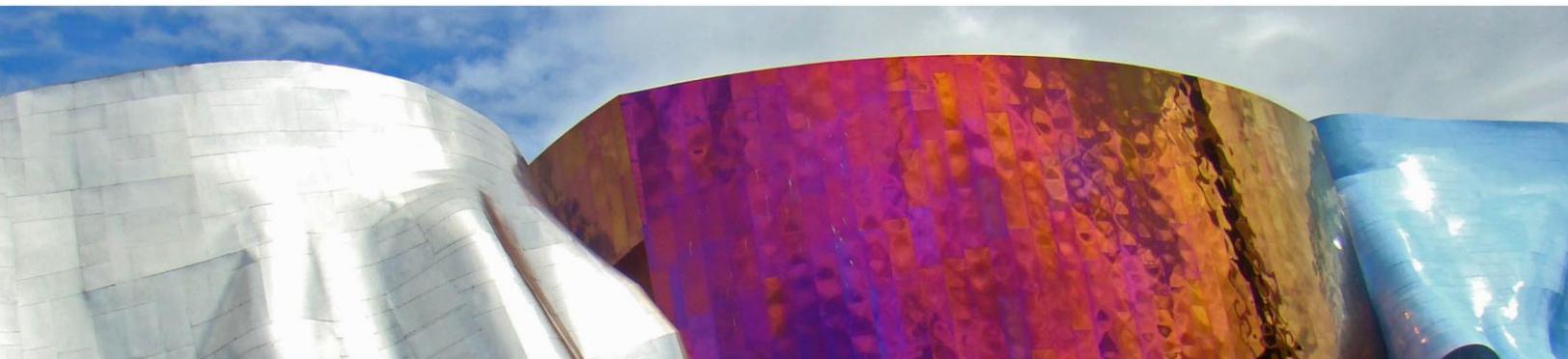

Presentation

Marshall Foster reviewed DPD's workplan from last year and presented the highlights of this coming year. Both reflect a shift in its creation; Marshall solicited feedback from the council and Mayor to better chart direction for the planning department. Marshall recapped work in 2011, such as the Capitol Hill Urban Design Framework, the Comp Plan, and the neighborhood plans. In 2012, the division will embark upon a citywide policy TOD, Columbia City Station area planning, corridor planning along Elliot and 15th, and translating the South Lake Union Urban Design Framework into a capital improvement program.
