The online system allows you to apply, pay for and self-issue certain types of electrical permits in real time **when no plan review is required**. You may pay for your permit using a credit card or DPD escrow (advance deposit) account. You may view and print the permit from your web browser in PDF format.

Types of Permits Not Available Via Self-Issuance

You can apply for all types of electrical permits using the online system, except for:

- Work that requires <u>electrical plan review</u> {note that this link will open a PDF document that explains when an electrical plan review is required}
- New fire alarm systems or changes to existing systems that involve more than 6 total control units/devices
- Additions, revisions, or address changes to permits already issued (even if they were issued by this system)
- Get-started/conditional work permits
- Hourly inspection permits (except in certain limited situations)
- Special event power
- More than one service for single-family/duplex occupancies
- Temporary power permits for multi-family, commercial, industrial, and commercial occupancy types of more than 399 amps.
