

**SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
SEATTLE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION COUNCIL RESOLUTION TO AMEND
CITY OF SEATTLE TRANSIT CLASSIFICATION MAP**

Description of Proposal: The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) proposes to amend the City of Seattle Transit Classification Map to include 44 additional street segments as Local, Minor or Major Transit Streets. Amending the Transit Classification Map will allow bus service on these streets, supports changes to bus service proposed by King County in the 2015 Transit Service Change program and allows better integration of bus service with Link Light Rail.

Location of Proposal: The streets proposed for reclassification are found throughout the City of Seattle.:


SDOT has determined that this proposal would not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information may be examined in the Seattle Department of Planning and Development Public Resource Center at 700 Fifth Ave, Suite 2000, Seattle. Documents are also available at the main branch of the Seattle Public Library, 1000 Fourth Ave, Seattle, WA 98104.

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2) and Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.05.340; the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the issue date below. **Comments must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. December 28, 2015.**



Box 94729, Seattle, WA 98124-4729, to the Office of the Hearing Examiner located on the 40th floor of the Seattle Municipal Tower at 700 Fifth Ave; telephone: (206) 684-0521. **The appeal must be in writing and filed no later than 5:00 p.m. January 4, 2016.** The appellant should be prepared to make specific factual objections.
