

**SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
SEATTLE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (SDOT)
FREIGHT MASTER PLAN**

Description of proposal: The non-project action will adopt, by resolution, the City of Seattle Freight Master Plan (FMP), a 20-year plan that parallels the Seattle Comprehensive Plan. The plan includes a policy framework section providing the vision and goals of the FMP as well as existing policies within the Comprehensive Plan that contributed to the development of the FMP. The FMP includes a proposed freight network to replace the current Major Truck Street (MTS) network for Seattle. The FMP provides an implementation plan in the form of projects, strategies and actions to advance the FMP goals.

Location of proposal including street address, if any: The Freight Master Plan applies to the entire City of Seattle.

Lead Agency: SDOT
