### **NOTICE OF CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENTS FOR THE 2013-2014 AMENDMENT CYCLE**

The City Council's Planning, Land Use, and Sustainability (PLUS) Committee will hold a public hearing on proposed Comprehensive Plan amendments for the 2014-2015 amendment cycle. The 2013-2014 amendments include:

- proposals to amend the Central Area neighborhood plan and the Future Land Use Map in the Central Area,
- a proposal to amend the Future Land Use Map and the Ballard-Interbay-Northend Manufacturing Industrial Center boundary.

### **PUBLIC HEARING**

The public hearing will be on Tuesday, April 1, 2014, at 2:00 in the Seattle City Council Chamber, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Seattle City Hall, 600 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The entrances to City Hall are located on the west side of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the east side of 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, between James and Cherry Streets. For those who wish to testify, a sign-up sheet will be available outside the Council Chamber one-half hour before the public hearing.
