This memorandum documents the completion of the SEPA process for the Addendum to the Environmental Checklist and the Threshold Determination of Non-Significance (DNS).

The Addendum was issued and sent to the Washington Department of Ecology SEPA Public Information Center on June 25, 2015, and was entered in the SEPA Register. The Addendum was also included in the Seattle Department of Planning and Development Land Use Information Bulletin on June 25th, and mailed to a distribution list based on the DNS issued for the project on March 9, 2015.

The comment period ended on July 10, 2015, and no comments were received.

The SEPA process is completed, and the project is authorized to proceed, contingent on any other required permits and approvals.
