

Seattle Voters Pamphlet 2018 – REVISED 7/26/18

Municipal Court Judges (Note: NEW DEADLINE)

Statements and photos for candidates **appearing on the General Election** ballot are due no later than **4pm on Friday, August 10, 2018**. This is a new, earlier deadline.

File your voters pamphlet statement with Seattle Ethics and Elections at ethicsandelections@seattle.gov, or in person at 700 5th Ave, Suite 4010, Seattle WA.

Statements can

- be up to 400 words long.
- include contact information for the candidate that will be included in the Voters Pamphlet, space permitting. This information does not count against the word limit. Candidates usually provide no more than three points of contact to fit within the allotted space.

Candidates must submit the statement in a format that can be easily converted to MS Word. If you want to send a pdf, you must also send a Word version.

Photos must

- not be more than two years old
- show only face, or face, neck and shoulders
- be on a plain, light background
- not include other people
- not show the candidate wearing a hat, button, or any article of clothing bearing an insignia, or a uniform, including but not limited to a judicial robe

Candidates must submit a 5"x7" photograph, or an electronic copy (eg. jpeg or pdf) with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi and a minimum printable size of 3.5"x 2.5".

Please include the name of the candidate and the position the candidate is running for (eg. Municipal Court Judge, Pos. 10) with all submissions. Please also provide contact information for staff to reach you should there be a problem with your submission.
