## Visit with Firefighters!

Fire station tours and firefighter school visits provide a unique opportunity for students to meet firefighters in person and learn how they work to keep our city safe. Groups of 25 or more may request a visit from their local station. Smaller groups may take a field trip to the local station.

## Learn Fire Safety!

Seattle Fire Department educators have developed lots of resources for teachers and group leaders to teach children important fire and life safety skills. Elementary level materials include an action packed *Safety Suitcase* for classroom use, or a free *Seattle Fire Department Activity Workbook* to easily integrate fire and life safety messages into the classroom.

## Fire Stoppers

Whenever a fire occurs at school, no matter how small, the Seattle Fire Department must be notified. If a student is involved in the incident, school policy requires that a referral be made to the Fire Stoppers Firesetting Intervention Program. The Fire Stoppers program engages children's interest and is informative for parents. It effectively halts firesetting behavior, while also providing families with resources and tools for keeping their family safe. Referral forms are available by calling 206-386-1338.
