

**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON
SEATTLE CITY COUNCIL PROPOSED LAND USE CODE AMENDMENTS RELATING
TO THE LOCATION OF NEW OR EXPANDING ADULT CABARETS**

Council Bill (C.B.) 115871 as originally proposed would amend the Land Use Code (Title 23 of the Seattle Municipal Code) to require that new or expanding adult cabarets (strip clubs) be at least a specified distance from two categories of land use, and to modify the method of calculating required parking. Relative to the existing zoning, this ordinance would reduce the area in which new or expanding adult cabarets could locate.

On May 23, 2007, the City Council's Urban Development and Planning Committee amended Council Bill 115871 to prohibit new or expanding adult cabarets in IG1 and IG2 (Industrial General 1 and Industrial General 2) zones *citywide*. (C.B. 115871 as introduced already prohibited new or expanding adult cabarets in IG1 and IG2 zones *in the Duwamish Manufacturing and Industrial Center*.)
