The Seattle City Council Transportation Committee will conduct a public hearing on **The S. Lander Street Grade Separation Project on Tuesday, June 12, 2007**, starting at **9:45 a.m.**

This project would fund a grade separation of the South Lander Street roadway and the Burlington Northern mainline railroad tracks between 1st Avenue South near the Starbucks Center, and 4th Avenue South. This project is being accelerated in order to begin construction in 2009, improving traffic safety, traffic flow east-west in the South Downtown area, freight traffic, and creating an alternative route to mitigate traffic impacts from the anticipated closure of the Alaskan Way Viaduct. The total estimated project cost is \$77,520,000.

ACCESS TO CITY HALL is via Fourth or Fifth Avenue, between James and Cherry Streets.

For those wishing to testify in person at the hearing, sign-up sheets will be available outside the door to Council Chambers at **9:15 a.m.** Councilmember Jan Drago will chair the hearing.
