NOTICE OF SEATTLE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ACQUISITION OF THE CAPEHART NAVAL HOUSING AREA IN DISCOVERY PARK

*The Seattle City Council Parks, Education, Libraries and Labor Committee will conduct a public hearing on **the acquisition of Capehart Naval Housing Area in Discovery Park on Wednesday, September 5, 2007, starting at 2:00 p.m.** (or at order of agenda)*

At this public hearing the Council Committee will be considering C.B. 115945, which if passed would authorize the purchase of Capehart Naval Housing Area (23.91 acre parcel of real property). The purpose of this proposed acquisition is to expand, enhance and preserve Discovery Park. To acquire the Capehart Naval Housing Area in Discovery Park, the Mayor entered into a tentative agreement subject to City Council authorization to purchase the area for eleven million, one hundred thousand dollars (\$11,100,000). Upon approval of the agreement and acquisition, the Capehart Naval Housing Area will be transferred to the Department of Parks and Recreation and be used for park and open space purposes.

ACCESS TO CITY HALL is via Fourth or Fifth Avenue, between James and Cherry Streets. For those wishing to testify in person at the hearing, sign-up sheets will be available outside the door to Council Chambers at **1:30 p.m.** Councilmember David Della will chair the hearing.
