Directions

City Hall is located at 600 Fourth Avenue. Council Chambers is on the 2nd Floor of City Hall.

Southbound on I-5: Take the James Street exit #165A and turn right on Columbia or James Streets.

Northbound on I-5: Take the James Street exit #164A and turn left on James Street.

After Hours Access:

City Hall is locked after 6:00 pm Mondays – Fridays. For access to an evening meeting after that time, go to southernmost door on the 5th Avenue entrance. Directly to the left (south) of the southernmost door, there is an intercom which is manned 24/7. Press the button and when the guard responds, tell him that you’re attending the meeting in chambers. They will electronically open the door nearest you.

City Hall Parking

There is no public event parking at City Hall other than a limited number of spaces that can be used for short-term needs. Nearby parking can be found in the SeaPark garage on Sixth and Cherry. City Hall is located one block due west of the garage. The vehicle entrances to the garage are on: 1) Cherry, mid-block between Fifth and Sixth Avenues; or 2) Sixth Avenue at James Street; or 3) James, mid-block between Fifth and Sixth Avenues.
