

NOTICE OF CAMPGROUND CLOSURE JULY 10, 2017

Seattle City Light is at the beginning of a 10-year program to implement new recreational improvements throughout the Boundary Hydroelectric Project area.

The first of these improvements will be redevelopment of the Forebay Recreation Area, including the addition of more campsites and day-use picnic sites, an extended boat launch, and new ADA amenities.

A temporary campground and boat launch closure will be in effect following the 2017 Fourth of July holiday and will last until the completion of construction activities.

The campground and boat launch will reopen by Spring 2018.
