TO APPLY, FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

Prior to installation

1. Apply for pre-approval by filling out and submitting the Home Owner Participation Form, available at www.seattle.gov/ductless.
2. Once you have received pre-approval from the Program, Seattle City Light will provide you with an Authorization Code via mail/email. You may then continue with the installation process with your contractor.

After installation

3. Your contractor must fill out and submit the Contractor Invoice Form available at www.seattle.gov/ductless

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please refer to the following terms and conditions prior to signing acceptance on reverse side:

- You must be a single family (1-4 units) residential customer of Seattle City Light and the installation address is in the Seattle City Light service territory.
- Ductless heat pump system must be installed on or between Jan. 1, 2013 and Dec. 31, 2013.
- This form must be postmarked within 90 days of the ductless heat pump installation date.
- Your current primary heating source for the home is electric resistance zonal heat or electric forced air furnace. Examples: electric resistance baseboards, Cadet or King wall heaters, hydronic baseboard heaters. [NOTE: homes with gas furnaces or oil heat, are not eligible.]
- Resident must agree to share one year's billing history before installation and have their energy use monitored for up to two years after installation.
- The installed ductless heat pump system must meet the following qualifications:
 - Equipment needs to employ an inverter-driven outdoor compressor, with inverter-driven or variable-speed indoor blowers and use R410A refrigerant.
 - Equipment must be installed per manufacturer's specifications by a participating Program Contractor (for a list of contractors, visit www.seattle.gov/ductless).
- Home Owner Participation Form, Contractor Invoice Form, and Seattle City Light Rebate Form must be provided before Seattle City Light can issue a rebate. All forms may be downloaded at www.seattle.gov/ductless

Seattle City Light ("SCL") will review the Owner or Authorized Personnel's ("Owner") rebate request application ("Request") and determine whether the installed Ductless Heat Pump (DHP) products qualify for the rebate. If the installed DHP products qualify, SCL will mail the appropriate rebate within thirty (30) days of SCL's receipt of the Request. Only one rebate is available per home. By signing this Request and accepting any rebate, Owner (1) represents and warrants that Owner has installed all Ductless Heat Pump products in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, codes, ordinances, including all building energy and accessibility codes and in compliance with the procedures specified by SCL for the Ductless Heat Pump Program; and (2) acknowledges and agrees that: (a) SCL has not and does not make any representations or promises with respect to the Ductless Heat Pump products, the energy consumption, and/or energy savings from the installed ductless heat pump products; and (b) that SCL MAKES NO IMPLIED OR EXPRESS WARRANTIES REGARDING THIS PROGRAM, ITS POLICIES, PROCEDURES, INSPECTIONS AND/OR ANY OWNER INSTALLED DUCTLESS HEAT PUMP PRODUCTS, AND SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.
