

Notice of Transmission Capacity for Resale

Seattle City Light Power Marketing (SCLM) is currently offering firm BPAT transmission capacity for resale for January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 and January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. Seattle is offering more than one year in duration, partially because the new rules of Preemption and Competition will only apply to transmission of duration of 12 months or less. The specifics of these offerings are shown in the table below.

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In summary, the offered services are as follows:

- **Product: Transmission Service for Reassignment**
 - Service Class: Firm.
 - Type: Point-to-Point (PTP) on the BPAT network.
- **Term:**
 - Varies depending on offering.
 - Bids can be made in monthly increments for portions of the stated quantities.
 - Minimum: monthly beginning with January 1, 2014.
 - Maximum: January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 and January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015.
 - Time: all times are stated in Pacific Prevailing Time (PPT)
- **Product Shape:**
 - Customer must request Flat (7x24) product shapes.
- **Quantities:** As specified in the table above.
 - OASIS offerings up to 300 MW on various paths.
 - Offer quantities may be adjusted by SCLM without notice until confirmed.

 - Customer can Redirect service to firm or non-firm reservations.

 - SCLM reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all bids and to modify this offer. Seattle may make partial / counteroffers, depending on other bids and other opportunities.
 - Assignment of this Firm Transmission Service to the Customer conveys no renewal or right of first refusal for transmission service beyond the period covered by this offer.
 - All Bidders must be a registered BPA customer; please include your BPA customer number, with your bid(s).
 - Bids with longer tenors will be given priority.
 - Preference will be given to first, third, and fourth quarter bids.
