



Utility Discount Program

Seattle City Light provides reduced utility rates to eligible income qualified residential customers.

There are three primary eligibility requirements:

1. Applicant must be a City Light Customer.
2. Total household income must be at or before 70% of the state median income.
3. The applicant is not eligible if they are receiving utility allowance through federally subsidized housing.

Those who do not qualify:

- Section 8 (both voucher and project based)
- HUD subsidized housing that provide utility allowance
- Shelter + Care

Those who may qualify:

- Tax credit housing
- BOND housing
- Minimum rent (SHA)
- Housing First
