Get a \$50 rebate on a qualified model when you recycle your old unit.

TO APPLY, FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

- 1. Your new qualified refrigerator must be purchased between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2012.** Read the Terms and Conditions on the back of this form to ensure you qualify.
- Complete the rebate form and attach a **copy** of itemized receipt. Receipt must include name of retailer, retailer address, phone number, purchase date, price, product manufacturer and model number.
- You must provide documentation that the old unit has been recycled. Ask the haul-away company or drop-off site for a receipt and attach it to this form. In the case where a receipt is not available, a signature from a representative of the haul-away company or drop-off site is required. See signature field in form below. For more information about arranging recycling haul-away, please see Terms and Conditions on back of this form.
- Sign and date the rebate form and send the completed form with itemized receipts postmarked **within 90 days of purchase** date to:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please refer to the following terms and conditions prior to signing acceptance on reverse side:

- You must be a customer of Seattle City Light and the installation address is in the Seattle City Light service area.
- One rebate per household please.
- This rebate request application must be postmarked within 90 days of the refrigerator purchase date.
- The installed refrigerator must meet the following qualifications:
 - New refrigerator must be purchased between Jan. 1, 2012 and Dec. 31, 2012.
 - ENERGY STAR rated
 - Minimum of 9 cubic feet (compact refrigerators are not eligible).
 - You must provide proof of recycling by submitting a receipt from the retailer, haul-away company or drop-off site. In the case where a receipt is not available, a signature from a representative of the haul-away company or drop-off site is required. Many retailers provide recycling haul-away services free of charge or for a minimal fee upon delivery of the new unit. If your local retailer does not provide this service, visit 1800recycle.wa.gov for a list of recycling providers.
- All information must be complete, and **copies** of itemized purchase receipt and proof of recycling receipt must be enclosed to be considered for payment.
- This rebate may not be combined with Seattle City Light's \$30 refrigerator recycling rebate.

Seattle City Light ("SCL") will review the rebate request application ("Request") and determine whether the purchased refrigerator product qualifies for the rebate. If the product qualifies, SCL will mail the appropriate rebate within (60) days of SCL's receipt of the Request. Only one rebate is available per home. By signing this Request and accepting any rebate, Owner (1) represents and warrants that the refrigerator product has been installed in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, codes, and ordinances, including all building energy and accessibility codes and in compliance with the procedures specified by SCL; and (2) acknowledges and agrees that: (a) SCL is a sponsor of the rebate program only and has not and does not make any representations or promises with respect to the refrigerator product, the energy consumption, and/or energy savings from the installed refrigerator product; and (b) that SCL MAKES NO IMPLIED OR EXPRESS WARRANTIES REGARDING THIS PROGRAM, ITS POLICIES, PROCEDURES, INSPECTIONS AND/OR ANY OWNER INSTALLED REFRIGERATOR PRODUCT, AND SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.
